We are excited to see you all back at school and want to make sure that we keep our school safe for everyone. It is important that all safety routines and protocols are followed closely.

IF YOU FEEL SICK OR HAVE SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME

What You Can Expect...



- Our school will be divided into cohorts of no more than 60 people.
- Cohorts will have an assigned line up spot for arrival/dismissal and an entrance/exit door
- Students are required to apply hand sanitizer and/or wash hands when entering and exiting the building.
- Thoroughly washing your hands with soap and water is the best protection against illness. Make sure you wash your hands frequently and for at least 20 seconds. When a sink isn't available, use the hand sanitizer provided around the school.
- Students will follow the arrows and pay attention to signs on doors and in halls.

Feeling Sick at Home or School?

- Complete a health safety check every day before coming to school. Do you have any cold or flu like symptoms or other respiratory symptoms? If so, contact the school to excuse report the absence.
- Feeling sick while at school? Let your teacher or the office know immediately. The office will contact home and have someone pick you up as soon as possible while you wait in the medical room.
- When home, contact your health-care provider immediately or call 811 and inform them of your symptoms.

Recess & Lunch Play...

- We will have 2 different recess and lunch breaks to accommodate a smaller number of students on our grounds at a time
- Students will only interact with students inside their cohort and will stay in their assigned playground zone. Zones will rotate weekly.

Daily Schedule...



- Students are asked to arrive just prior to school starting and go immediately to their class line ups. Please remember to maintain social distancing from others when heading to your cohort.
- Teachers will greet their class outside and bring them in when the bell rings.
- Families are encouraged to leave the property immediately after dismissal to ensure proper physical distancing is maintained outside of classroom cohorts.

Washrooms and Water Fountains...



- Only use the bathroom closest to your classroom- teachers will review the process
- Maximum 2 people in the bathroom at one time; maintain physical distancing
- Handwashing guidelines are posted in washrooms
- Hands must be washed again upon re-entry into a learning space
- Water fountains are available only for filling water bottles. Students wash or sanitize hands before and after use.

- Teachers will still expect students to wash hands as per our guidelines

Masks For Us and For You...



Many of you have asked about masks; we will be following the Re-start Plan guidelines which are coordinated with the BCCDC.

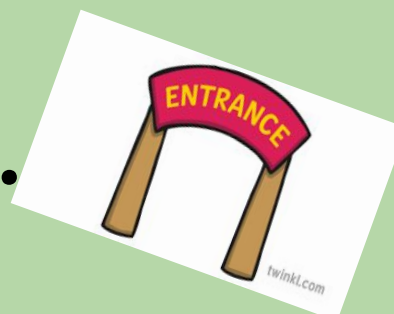
- Students are not required to wear masks, but may if they wish.
- You will notice staff wearing masks in common areas, when they cannot guarantee they can maintain safe distance. We ask that if you are in the building, you do the same. Masks are required when in high traffic areas such as hallways, or whenever physical distancing cannot be maintained.

If You Are Late...



- If you come to school and you are only a few minutes late, check to see if your class is still outside.
- If your class has already entered the building, go to the front door and our office staff will bring you in.
- Please be patient if you are at the front door for this reason - it takes time to interact with each individual and family.

Coming into the building...



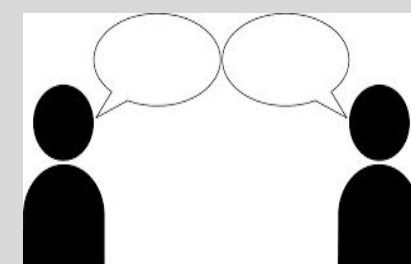
- Of course, we want to connect with you. For now if you would like to / need to talk with us, please ring the doorbell or call the office and we will come to the door to help. Unfortunately, you will not be able to visit classrooms / hallways / go to classes with students.
- Visitors coming to the building must sign in at the front door and visit the office so we know who is in the building at all times.
- We ask that you please do not enter through other doors (at times, they will be open so students and staff can come and go to the washroom or enter the building during break times)

Be Ready for Rain...



- Please ensure your family is prepared for rain before school, during the day, and after school.
- Waterproof clothing is going to be necessary as we will be outside regardless of the weather.

Talking with us in the office...or talking with your teacher...



- As much as possible, we will be limiting contact by talking over the phone or meeting remotely if necessary. We ask that you respect this as much as possible so we can keep our staff / students healthy.
- If you need to talk with us in the office, please phone us, email us or, if you are at the front door, ring the doorbell / call and we will help you.
- If you need to talk with your teacher, let them know at drop off / pick up times, contact them by email, or call and leave a message in the office so they can get back to you when they are not teaching.

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
